

Reimagining Justice Conference

November 20, 2025

The Minnesota Justice Research Center's (MNJRC) annual <u>Reimagining Justice Conference</u> (<u>RIJC</u>) brings together criminal justice practitioners, legal experts, scholars, and advocates to reimagine a justice system that functions more effectively, humanely and with the public's trust.

This year, the 2025 RIJC will be held on Thursday, November 20th, after the local elections in Minneapolis and five years after the murder of George Floyd and the uprising that followed, creating an opportunity to dig into innovative approaches to public safety.

The conference program is designed to spark dynamic conversation about policing and highlight opportunities for change. Panel discussions will focus on the Minneapolis Police Department (MPD) consent decree, Appropriate Response Models like the Minneapolis Behavioral Crisis Response (BCR), and an examination of how well MPD solves crimes along with an exploration of how to increase clearance rates. Finally, restorative justice circles will invite participants to talk about efforts to repair trust and showcase the work of the Police and Black Men Project.

Overall, the vision for the 2025 RIJC focuses on encouraging people to commit to progress and utilize every tool available to develop a model for excellence that we can proudly call the "Minneapolis Model for Public Safety."
